■ BIOGRAPHY

Taig is the most successful athlete in the history of extreme sport (75 victories in 115 professional competitions in 6 years), ramp skating triple world champion, winner of the X Games, the Gravity Games, and the ASA tournament. In 2001, he became the first extreme sports athlete to do a double back-flip in competition. That year, he also won the X Games, the Gravity Games, the world championship, Bercy (Paris), & the European X-Games. On 29 May 2010 Taig Khris set a new world record of 12.5 metres (39 feet) for the longest freefall from a structure onto a landing ramp by jumping off a platform built onto the first level of the Eiffel Tower (40m) in Paris. He is preparing another extreme sport challenge for this July in Paris.

Taig will be taking a break from his training in Woodward, Pennsylvania to be with us.

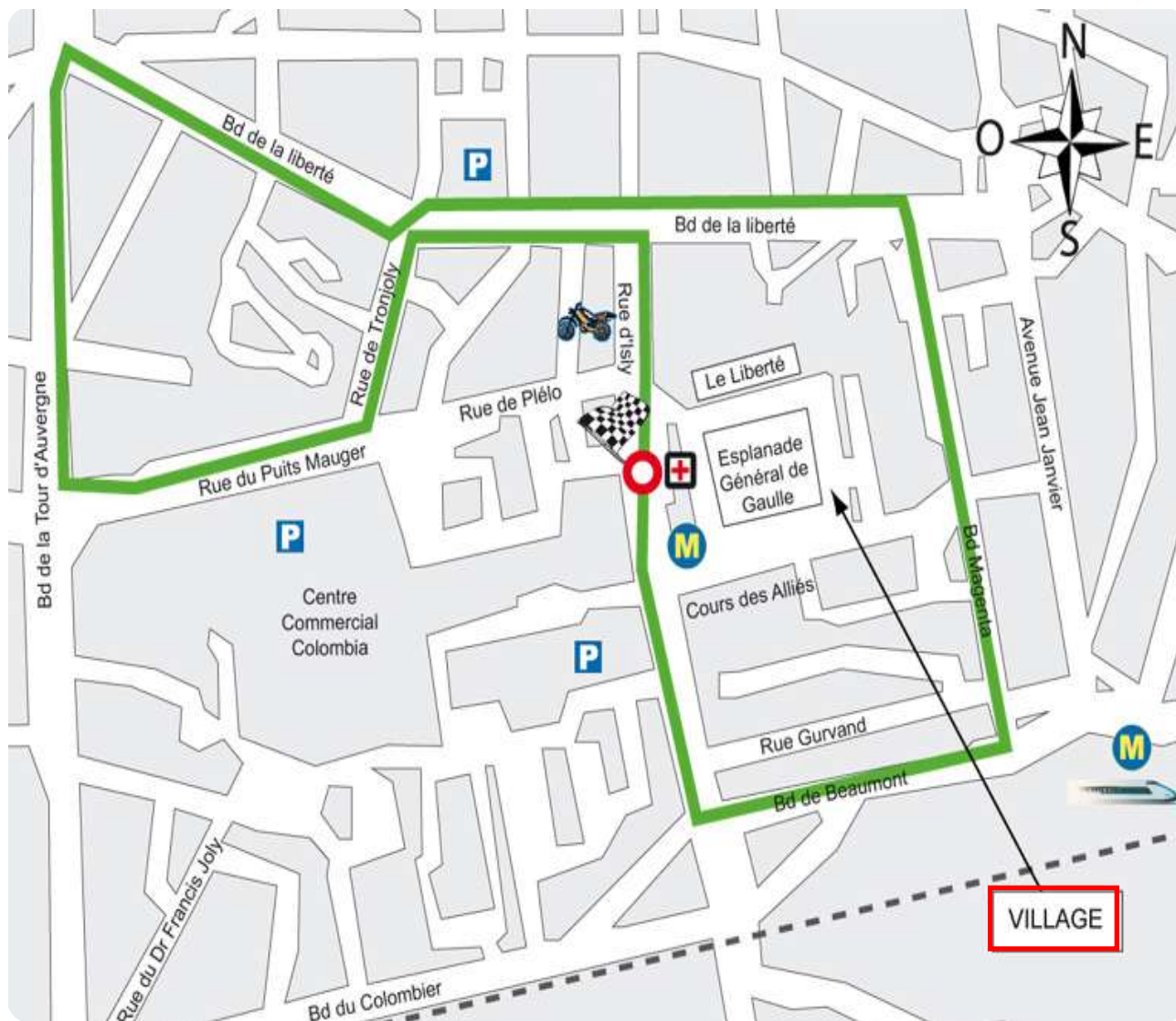
Map of the race circuit

A technical and demanding race circuit in the city centre

Following **Rennes' main boulevards** (Bd de la Liberté, Bd de la Tour d'Auvergne, Bd Beaumont, Bd Magenta), the **2.8-km** race circuit proves to be **very demanding** with fast corners, **tight bends**, and **straight stretches** enabling skaters to reach speeds of **over 60 km/h**, especially in the Rue d'Isly, during the **sprints**.

Event highlights since 1982!

1982 The first 'Rennes sur Roulettes'. Over 30 years ago, a few 'crazy' roller skaters started thinking about organising a participative leisure event, which would be open and accessible to everyone. As well as being free-of-charge, there would be a competitive element, reserved for the sport's local, regional, national, and international elite.

1987 First International Marathon

1992 900 skaters took part in the street skate. The international marathon was won by the Italian, MARIANI

1994 The number of skaters passed the 2,000 mark. The international marathon was won by the Belgian, WILLEMS

1995 3,200 skaters took part in the street skate, 10,000 spectators, The world champion, Arnaud GICQUE, won the international marathon.

1996 5,000 skaters covered a distance of 58,000 Km, 25,000 spectateurs. 300 athletes took part in the international competitions. TV coverage on the main French channels.

1997 Final of the Bauer Inline Festival, Cyclist / Skater challenge with Frédéric Magné, world track cycle racing champion.

1999 The event took on a whole new dimension with the hosting of **the final of the European Inline Cup 1999!**

2000 Final stage of the International Grand Prix 2000

2002 '20th birthday' with the 3rd stage of the World Inline Cup

2003 The 4th stage of the World Inline Cup – won by the Swiss, Pia KNECHT (Team Salomon), and the world champion, the Colombian, Jorge BOTERO (Team Rollerblade).

2004 Sun, spectators, and records! Hakim Naït Chahal set a new world high jump record of 2.75m, Participation of the best European rider, Nel Martin. 3rd stage of the World Inline Cup – honours going to 2 Italians: Laura LARDINI (Team Rollerblade) for the **women** and Massimiliano PRESTI (Team Fila) for the men.

2005 Never before seen at 'Rennes sur Roulettes'! The indoor events at Le Liberté brought together an enthusiastic & awestruck audience for the **French Ramp Championship. Cyclist / skater challenge** with **Michaël.BOURGAIN** (world vice-champion, individual inline speed skating). Alexis CONTIN from Saint-Malo won the World Inline Cup marathon.

2006 Another outstanding success for the 24th event!!! With the participation of all ages and all levels - from recreational skaters to the international elite – all the ingredients were **brought** together to celebrate this roller festival – the only one of its kind in France. The International Open Ramp competition was won by Kevin Marron, whilst the Italians, Simona Di Eugenio & Massimiliano Presti won the WIC marathons.

2007 25 years of 'Rennes sur Roulettes'. The rainy weather did nothing to dampen the spirits of the 4,800 street skaters or the Swiss, Roger Schneider, and the German, Jana Gegner, who won the WIC International Marathons. Hats off too to the riders who braved the wind and rain to pit themselves against each other in the FISE Experience urban street events.

2008 The 26th 'Roulettes'. Saturday's programme was cut short a bit as events were often rained off. Even the star event, Saturday evening's street skate, had to be cancelled. It was a totally different picture on Sunday which was very sunny. The riders who had stayed in the Breton capital battled it out in impressive fashion in the street sport area. The international marathons brought the event to a spectacular finish with the crowds of spectators at the finishing line holding their breath to witness a double Colombian victory for Diego ROSERO and Cecilia BAENA.

2009 The 27th 'Rennes sur Roulettes' was back again at its showpiece venue, the Esplanade Général de Gaulle, where urban sports come alive! Colourful street skates, a record number of people wanting to learn inline skating, class and craziness at the street-park, which hosted a stage of the FISE Experience, and finesse and grace in the French Jump/Slalom Cup, before Nicole BEGG and Nicolas ITEN gave winning performances in the 2nd stage of the World Inline Cup..

2010 The 28th 'Roulettes', with Rennes still at the forefront of the roller scene! The event expertly livened up the city centre. There were 3,500 participants in tSunday morning's family street skate – a great performance for the start of the spring holidays! The stage of the FISE Experience and the roller/BMX shows animated the Village at the highest level - in all senses of the term. As for the races, there was a **'first' for our sport** in France with the live broadcasting on the TV channel, **France 3 Ouest**, of the International Marathon! which counts towards the WIC. With a Colombian victory for Cecilia Baena in the women's race and a win for the New Zealander, Scott Arlidge, in the men's race, two opposite parts of the world were brought together !
